SPANISH DAY!



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Bienvenido a tu Día Español - Welcome to your Spanish Day!

Make today a day all about Spanish, Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries.

In this pack, you'll find some ideas for how to bring Spanish into your day. Go through the activities below at home together - even if you just say a few words and sentences, that's a real achievement and will help foster a love of speaking Spanish at home.



SPANISH TIP #1!

Make a simple paper mask. Label it: **Hablo español** - I speak Spanish. Wear the mask when you want to speak some Spanish.

Hablo español

To start the day, say hello in Spanish to your family or those you live with:

Hola, buenos días mamá - Hello, good morning mum

Hola, buenos días papá - Hello, good morning dad

Hola, buenos días... (hermana) - Hello, good morning... (sister)

Hola, buenos días... (hermano) - Hello, good morning... (brother)

Hola, buenos días abuela/yaya... - Hello, good morning grandmother/granny

Hola, buenos días abuelo/yayo - Hello, good morning grandfather/grandpa

Hola, buenos días... - Hello, good morning... (Who else lives with you? What do you call them?)

¿Qué tal? - How are you? How are things?

You can answer: **Bien, gracias** - Good, thanks.

SPANISH TIP #2!

Arrange a small area in your house, maybe the corner of the kitchen. Put up a notice: **¡Aquí hablamos español!** - Here we speak Spanish!

Hora de comer (Time to eat)

What do you have for breakfast? Spanish children might have some of the following for breakfast or lunch:

- **un bocadillo de queso o jamón** - cheese or ham sandwich (usually made with a crusty bread roll)
- **una tostada con tomate** - toast rubbed with garlic, olive oil and pulped fresh tomato
- **una tortilla** - a potato omelette
- **los churros** - long thin doughnuts
- **el zumo de naranja** - orange juice
- **la leche** - milk
- **el agua** - water




Draw and cut out pictures of the food.

Then put the pictures on a plate.

Now say in Spanish what you'd like for breakfast and put the food on the plate!

For example: **Quiero...un bocadillo, por favor**
- I'd like a sandwich, please

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Time for school!
¿Vas a la escuela hoy? Are you going to school today?
Sí/No-Yes/No

Draw a picture of how you go to school. Say it out loud in Spanish.

- Voy a pie** - I go on foot
- Voy en el bus** - I go by bus
- Voy en coche** - I go by car
- Voy en el tren** - I go on the train
- Voy en bici** - I go on my bike

Did you notice that in Spanish you have a question mark and an exclamation mark at the **beginning and at the end** of a sentence?

SPANISH TIP #4! Is there a special event going on in Spain today that you can celebrate at home? Why not decorate your house and get your family to join in!



Time for a quick quiz!
